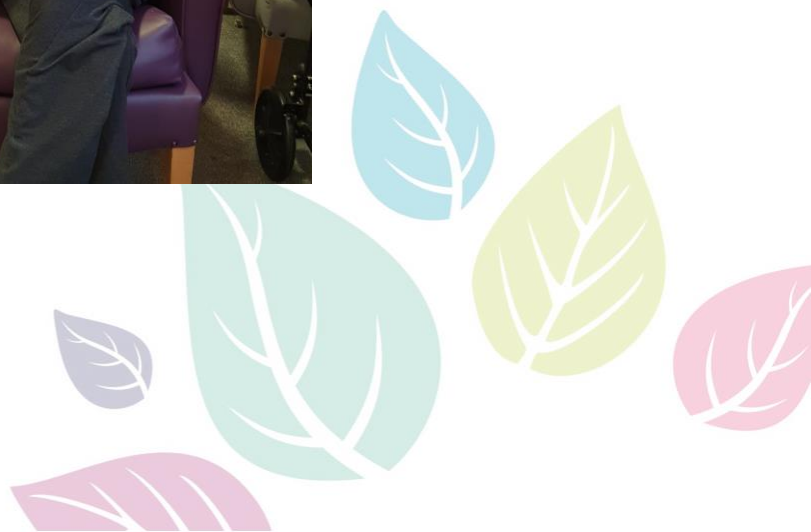
Our December Activities

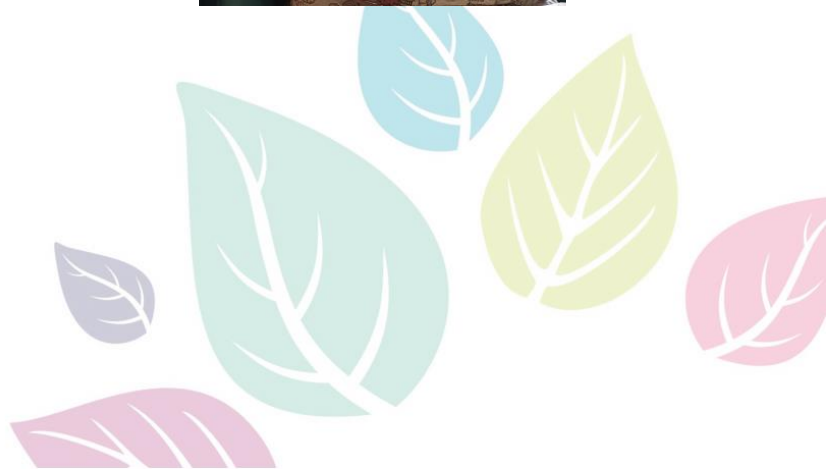
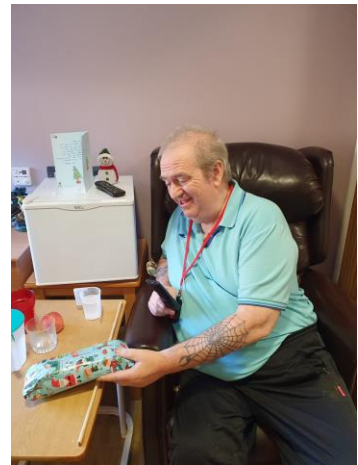




Father Christmas has been!
